

Outline of Hokkaido University International House

The International House was established for international students in order to give a comfortable life during their studies at Hokkaido University.

1. Brief description of each dormitory

<Keiteki-Ryo>

Address: 3 banchi, Kita 18, Nishi 13, Kita-ku, Sapporo 060-0818, Japan

Accommodation: 40 rooms for male students Established in 1983

Expenses: Rent - ¥4,700 per month

Utilities charges – Around ¥5,000~¥7,000 per month

Common space: Shower rooms, lounges with kitchen, washstand/laundry rooms, lavatories

Equipment in each room: Bed, desk, chair, bookshelf, locker, desk lamp, refrigerator, panel heater, hanger shelf, trash box, curtains.

Note: Japanese students also live in this dormitory. Internet is available (Residents have to contract and pay for the Internet by themselves).

Accommodation: 21 rooms for female students Established in 1984

Expenses: Rent -¥4,700 per month (6 rooms are ¥4,300 per month)

Utilities charges – Around ¥5,000~¥7,000 per month

Common space: Shower rooms, lounges with kitchen, washstand/laundry rooms, lavatories

Equipment in each room: Bed, desk, chair, bookshelf, locker, desk lamp, refrigerator, panel heater, hanger shelf, trash box, curtains.

Note: Japanese students also live in this dormitory. Internet is available. (Residents have to contract and pay for the Internet by themselves).

(This charges is made to cover disposal of bulky refuse.)

Equipment in each room: Unit bath, kitchen, gas heater, bed, desk, chair, bookshelf, wardrobe, desk lamp, refrigerator, shoes box, curtains.

Common space: Kitchens, dining rooms, washrooms, mail boxes, lavatories, lounge,

2. Application of occupancy

In principle, selection of residents is made biannually in February and July by the Division of International Affairs Department, through the *Kyomu-Tanto* (Academic Affairs Section) at each faculty. In addition, if there are vacant rooms, the *Kyomu-Tanto* can apply at any time.

3. Other

- **Except for Sosei-Ryo, lodging expenses and service charge will be automatically withdrawn. (In case of short term visit, on the month of departure and past one, residents must pay in cash.)**
- The allocation of rooms is determined by the University. You cannot change rooms or dormitories.
- As each residence has kitchens, residents can cook their own meals.
- There is no parking area for residents in the dormitories. Personal parking in or around the dormitory may be evicted.
- If residents delay in their rent more than 2 months, they may be evicted.
- Residents are responsible for paying a fee for the lost of their keys, or if equipment is damaged.
- Residents of any dormitory can borrow bedlinens. Hokkaido University International House and Sapporo International House residents must pay a cleaning charge for bedlinens through the Hokudai COOP. Keiteki-Ryo and Sosei-Ryo residents must pay about ¥3,300 when they vacate. Please consult when you move in.
- Residents of Sosei-ryo are responsible for cleaning up their own rooms and their personal belongings will be disposed when they leave dormitory.
- Residents of Hokudai International House are required to pay cleaning fee before vacating. The amount charge will depend on when you enter. Sapporo International House does not charge room cleaning fee if the room is left in a good condition.
- Residents are required to observe the rules and regulations of their residences. Persons who cause serious trouble may have their residency status revoked.
- All dormitories have Internet service. (Also confirm “1. Brief description of each house” about fee.)
- All residents living Hokkaido University International House more than three months are required to pay ¥30,000 as a deposit at the time of the first payment.
